

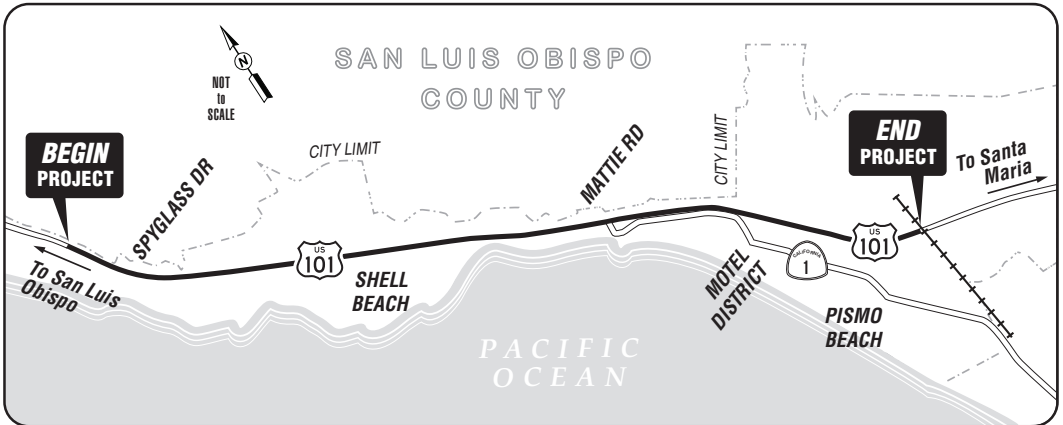

Pismo Congestion Relief Project on US 101

WHAT IS BEING PLANNED?

Caltrans and San Luis Obispo Council of Governments are planning improvements to operations on southbound US 101 between Spyglass Drive and the Pismo Railroad overhead by providing a part-time travel lane on the left inside shoulder. The shoulder would be used as a part-time travel lane during peak travel periods on weekdays and for special events. The extension of the truck climbing lane, improvements to southbound Mattie Road ramps, and the potential closure of the Shell Beach Road on-ramp will also be presented.

WHY THIS PUBLIC NOTICE?

Caltrans will hold a meeting to solicit public and agency input on the development of the environmental scope of the Environmental Impact Report (EIR) and Environmental Assessment (EA) for the project. All written input from public outreach activities conducted by the Department and its representatives will be considered in the preparation of the EIR/EA.

WHAT'S AVAILABLE?

Preliminary project mapping, technical staff, and informational displays will be available at the meeting. A presentation will occur at 7:00 pm.

WHERE DO YOU COME IN?

This is your opportunity to provide input into the types of environmental impacts and potential mitigation strategies that should be considered during the developmental process of the EIR/EA. Your written comments will be part of the public record.
