

How long will an inspection take?

Inspection times vary

- Initial Inspections: ~ 1 hour
- Follow up Inspections:
~ 15 to 30 minutes
- Inspection times increase with the number of noted discrepancies



How often do we conduct inspections?

- FSE inspections are typically conducted on a 6, 12 and 24 month basis
- Inspections conducted more often in areas where fats, oils and grease are observed in the sewer system, “ Hot Spots”
- Follow up inspections may be necessary with Notices of Non-Compliance

Recordkeeping

- The FSE shall maintain written records of grease interceptor maintenance for three (3) years
- Service records shall be available for inspection at all times
